

# Spiritual Discipline Outline: Sharing

## Big Idea

The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation, and we are called to share it boldly. God has not given us a spirit of fear but of power, love, and a sound mind. We are to share both God's story of redemption and our personal testimony, trusting that the Holy Spirit will give us the words and that our stories have power to overcome the enemy and unlock others' prisons.

## Scripture (KJV)

- Romans 1:16; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; John 3:16; Matthew 10:19-20; 2 Timothy 1:7-8; Joshua 1:9; Acts 17:24-28; Psalm 96:2-4; Revelation 21:1-4; 1 Peter 3:15; Acts 1:8; Revelation 12:11.

## Discover

- The Gospel is God's love letter: Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose on the third day.
- The Gospel is the power of God unto salvation; it has the power to transform lives.
- God's love is demonstrated in John 3:16: He gave His only Son so we might have eternal life.

## Learn

- Overcoming Fear: Fear is the biggest obstacle to evangelism, but God has not given us a spirit of fear. The Holy Spirit will give us the words to speak. Be strong and courageous; God is with you.
- Sharing God's Story: The Bible is one unified narrative of Creation, Fall, Redemption, and Restoration. We declare His glory and share the hope of a new heaven and new earth.
- Sharing Your Story: Always be ready to give a reason for your hope. Your testimony has power to overcome the enemy and unlock others' prisons.

- Practice explaining the Gospel in your own words: Christ died, was buried, and rose again.
- Write down your testimony: How has God transformed your life?
- Identify one person to share the Gospel or your testimony with this week.
