# Sharing God's Story

The Biblical Narrative from Genesis to Revelation

When we think about the Bible, we might see it as a collection of stories, but it is truly one unified narrative that reveals God's plan for humanity. From Genesis 1:1 to Revelation 22:21, we see God's overarching purpose to redeem His creation.

**The Bible tells of God's story through four movements:**

## Creation

We begin by seeing the work of God through His creation. The world was made good, and humanity was created in God's image to have relationship with Him.

## Fall

We then see the fall of humanity that resulted in separation between God and us. Sin entered the world, bringing death and brokenness.

## Redemption

But fear no more—a Messiah is here! Through His Son Jesus Christ, God's plan to redeem us into His Kingdom is revealed.

*John 3:16-17*

## Restoration

The promise of a new creation exists with no sin or death. A new heaven and new earth where God dwells with His people forever.
